



## George Haines Scholarship

The George Haines Scholarship was established in 1994. Mr. Haines retired from Armstrong Machine Company in Three Rivers after 25 years of loyal service. He was very interested in assisting students pursuing a career in an occupational field. Students wishing to pursue a career that is related to their Career and Technical Education (CTE) program are eligible for this scholarship.

This scholarship will be awarded on the basis of a competitive process which considers all information provided on the student application.

Scholarship awards are made at the discretion of the Superintendent of the St. Joseph County Intermediate School District based on Scholarship Committee recommendations. All awards are made without regard to race, creed, color, sex, religion, or national origin.

### REQUIREMENTS

- ☞ High School seniors must complete the application and return it to their high school counselor or CTE instructor **NO LATER THAN THURSDAY, MARCH 1, 2018**. The counselor/instructor will then submit it to Thomas Cameron, Director of Career and Technical Education, at the St. Joseph County I.S.D.
- ☞ Scholarship recipients will be notified in May.
- ☞ Scholarships will be awarded to St. Joseph County students enrolled in a Career and Technical Education program.
- ☞ Funds may be used for tuition, books and on-campus room and board.
- ☞ The Three Rivers Community Foundation will disburse funds to colleges directly.
