ENTER TO WIN UP TO \$500 TO MAKE YOUR IDEA HAPPEN!

Rules:

1. Any nonprofit organization, business, or individual is eligible to apply. Limit one application per nonprofit organization, business, or individual.
2. Submit your idea: Provide a brief project description (250 – 300 characters) as well as a detailed summary (not exceeding 1 page) of your project, why it will benefit Three Rivers, and how you will complete it. Include a picture/visual representation of your idea. **Submissions must be received via email to melissa@threeriversfoundation.com by Friday, August 7th at 4:30 p.m.**
3. Projects must be for the benefit of Three Rivers and townships that fall within the Three Rivers school district and cannot be for personal or business benefit.
4. Grants awarded must be used to complete the proposed project. This includes new projects or programs, program enhancement within the scope of work, or expansion of an already existing project.
5. Submissions will be reviewed and the top 10 ideas (determined by the foundation board) will be posted to the foundation's Facebook page. All submissions will remain anonymous. The community will have the chance to vote on the project(s) they wish to see happen in the community. The voting period will begin Thursday, August 13th at 8:00 a.m. and conclude on Monday, August 17th at 4:30 p.m.
6. Voters can vote for multiple projects, but may only give one (1) vote per project.
7. The top five (5) ideas with the most votes will be awarded a grant of up to \$500 to make their project happen!

All application entries become the property of the Three Rivers Area Community Foundation. All submissions will be reviewed by the foundation, which will choose the top 10 submissions to be voted on by the public via the foundation's Facebook page, facebook.com/ThreeRiversAreaCommunityFoundation. The foundation will post the project description (250 – 300 characters) and photo/illustration depicting your project. Each 'like' received for that project will count as one (1) vote. There is a limit

of one (1) vote per project per Facebook account. The five (5) projects with the most votes ('likes') will receive funding up to \$500. Voting will begin at 8:00 a.m. on Thursday, August 13th and will conclude on Monday, August 17th at 4:30 p.m. Winning applicants will be announced on Friday, August 21st at 10:00 a.m. via the foundation's Facebook page. Winners will also be notified via email. Winning applicants must complete projects by Monday, September 21st. The foundation reserves the right to exclude applications that do not meet mini grant criteria. As with all of our grants, decisions are subject to foundation Board or Directors' approval.
