PURPOSE

To provide financial assistance for higher education learning.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Graduate from a St. Joseph County High School with preference given to graduates of Three Rivers High School.
2. Have attained a minimum grade point average of 3.0 in high school.
3. Pursuing higher education.
4. Be available for a personal interview with the scholarship selection committee.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship shall be in the amount of \$1,000.

SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Selection Committee shall include 3-5 representatives from the following:

- 1) Three Rivers Community Schools, 2) St. Joseph County Intermediate School District.
