

## 2019 DOROTHY HIATT NURSING SCHOLARSHIP

### HISTORY

This scholarship was established by her family to honor Dorothy Hiatt, R.N. She embraced the Nursing profession at Three Rivers Area Hospital and dedicated 41 years to caring for others. Patients, families and coworkers admired Dorothy for her skills as an excellent nurse and administrator.

### PURPOSE

To provide financial assistance to students in the field of nursing.

### ELIGIBILITY

Applicants for this scholarship must satisfy the following criteria:

1. Be currently enrolled in an accredited nursing program.
2. Have already completed at least two terms in an accredited nursing school program.
3. Be a resident of St. Joseph County or Kalamazoo County in Southwest Michigan.
4. Be a US Citizen.
5. Be available for a personal interview, upon request of the scholarship recipient selection committee.

### AMOUNT OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is awarded annually in the amount of \$500 to be used for tuition and books. Full time and part time nursing students will be considered for the scholarship award. There is no restriction on the number of times a nursing student may be awarded this scholarship; however, the scholarship is not automatically renewable. Nursing students who have received a scholarship are encouraged to reapply in subsequent years.

- Include a copy of your school transcripts.
